Subject: Urgent Reminder*: Mandatory Transplant Registration on NOTTO Portal and Data Reporting to SOTTOs/ROTOs and NOTTO

Dear Sir/Madam,

The National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organization (NOTTO), under the Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, is entrusted with the statutory responsibility of establishing and maintaining a National Transplant Registry pursuant to Section 13D of the Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Act (THOTA), 1994. This registry is essential for monitoring organ and tissue transplantation activities, ensuring transparency, facilitating equitable organ allocation, and supporting policymaking to enhance organ and tissue donation in the country.

It is a matter of serious concern that many registered transplant hospitals have persistently failed to submit the daily and monthly data on organ transplantation activities and register transplantations on the National Transplant Registry. Such non-compliance undermines NOTTO's ability to fulfill its mandated obligations and impedes the overarching objective of augmenting organ donation rates nationwide. The urgency of this matter is further underscored by recent communications, including the D.O. letter dated 29th December 2023 from the Secretary (Health & Family Welfare) (Ref: D.O.No.D-26/657/R&D/NOTTO/23) and the D.O. letter dated 10th April 2024 from the Director General of Health Services (Ref: No. D-28/676/Coord/NOTTO/24), which highlight the need for comprehensive data sharing and monitoring of transplant activities.

In strict adherence to the provisions of the THOTA Act, 1994, all registered hospitals are required to maintain records of transplantation activities and report them to NOTTO through the respective State Organ and Tissue Transplant Organizations (SOTTOs). To rectify this lapse, you are requested to direct Hospitals/Transplant Centers to furnish comprehensive data as follows:

- **Data Reports:** Data related to deceased as well as living donors and recipients must be compiled, verified, and submitted to NOTTO through the respective SOTTO and ROTTO. This data should be reported on a monthly basis (latest by the first week of the subsequent month) as per the enclosed formats (Annexures 1, 2, 3, and 4).
- **National Registry:** It is mandatory to update data online on the NOTTO web portal regularly and register both donors and recipients of living transplants in the National Transplant Registry (<https://notto.mohfw.gov.in/Admin/Login.aspx>) within 48 hours of the transplant procedure.

The State Appropriate Authority (SAA), which has the powers of a civil court under the Act, is requested to ensure compliance with the provision of data by hospitals for the National Transplant Registry. After verification by the SAA, the data must be forwarded to NOTTO through the
